Project examples



Queenstown area campus and road safety audits

2025 | Partnered with the Lightfoot Initiative ViaStrada carried out accessibility and road safety audits for 13 schools in the Queenstown Lakes District, supporting the development of school travel plans. We created online student travel surveys and a web app to show improvement opportunities. We also conducted safety assessments to guide practical recommendations.



Whangārei travel plan pilots

2023—24 | We worked with the Northland Transportation Alliance to develop School Travel Planning pilot support services for Whangārei including engagement materials, travel mode survey tool, maps, travel plan template and a School Travel Planning toolkit.



Palmerston North STPs and programme guidance

2018—20 | We developed School Travel Plans for five schools by working closely with council staff, school principals, NZ Police, and other stakeholders. The plans were informed by audits, surveys, and community engagement. We also reviewed a Bikes in Schools programme and designed a Junior Road Safety Track to teach young children safe cycling and walking skills.



Dunedin central city schools road safety study

2017—18 | Undertook a study aimed at addressing road safety issues around a cluster of five central-city schools. We made recommendations for infrastructure treatment solutions that provide a better environment for a broader range of travel options, and make active transport more feasible.







Hastings iWay school travel plans

2016—19 | Developed School Travel plans for nine schools within the district, and assisted the Council with their own Workplace Travel Plan. The School Travel Plans formed part of the Hastings iWay 10-year plan—a focused investment in street infrastructure, education and encouragement—which ViaStrada also helped develop.



Christchurch Aranui Connections

2022—24 | Provided technical input from concept to detailed design to make local streets safer and more people-friendly. Using a tactical urbanism approach, the project trialled low-cost street changes informed by strong community engagement, including design jams with students at three local schools. The result: reduced traffic speeds, safer crossings, and more walking and biking to school.
