2nd Annual Travel Demand Management Conference in New Zealand Tuesday 11 March 2008, The Rendezvous Hotel, Mayoral Drive, Auckland CBD

Travel Demand Management is becoming an increasingly important tool for the management of traffic congestion and parking and influencing the demand for travel and how and when trips take place. This increased importance also reflects the concerns over the local and global environmental effects of private vehicle based travel, and the need for more sustainable solutions.

This conference will be essential for all transport practitioners in central or local government, developers, transport operators, and transportation and planning consultants and advisors. It is also particularly applicable to those practitioners, employers, business associations and others involved in delivering individual or area wide travel plans.

The conference will debate a number of 'hot topics' which are of paramount importance to transport planners and travel plan practitioners as they deliver travel plans within the context of the New Zealand land use planning structure.

The first session will focus on the success of travel plans in the context of whether they are voluntary or compulsory. The conference speakers will share their experience and expertise through the delivery presentations and case studies based on producing travel plans within voluntary or compulsory scenarios.

All travel plans should be set up with targets which should be monitored and tested on a regular basis. The second session of the conference will examine monitoring and enforcement techniques used in the travel plan process. This session will explore practical monitoring programmes and deliver case studies to demonstrate enforcement techniques that ensure travel plans become operational and not ineffectual documents produced just in order to gain planning consent.

The afternoon session of the conference will explore other TDM issues, including some of the innovations that are current in the delivery of New Zealand TDM policy and practices.
